




Funder policies for OA to DATA



"Publicly funded research data are a public good (...), which should be made openly available with as few restrictions as possible..."

DON'T I OWN MY DATA?

Yes, but you have to abide by terms and conditions agreed upon when accepting the grant



WHAT IS RESEARCH DATA?

"...factual material commonly retained by and accepted in the scientific community as necessary to validate research findings..."

Why would I share my data?

- Make it available to people outside your group
- Better management of your own data:
 - "This person already left, I don't know where's their data"
 - o "I think I've done this experiment... the results should be somewhere..."
 - "But I didn't ask my participants for the consent form..."

Strictest data policy

All publications published on/after 1st May 2015 need a statement describing how to access the underlying research data

EPSRC will do random checks on publications:

- Is there a statement?
- Is data accessible?





How to share data?

- Describe your data (metadata)
- Deposit your data in suitable repositories
- Use DOIs (Digital Object Identifiers)
- Store data for at least 10 years from the last access





Exemptions

- Personal/sensitive data
- IP protection/commercial data
- Too expensive to share

Appropriate statement in the publication needs to explain the reasons for restrictions



Other funders

- Require Data Management Plans
- MRC: Data Plans should be updated annually
- ESRC and NERC: preferred data repositories
- BBSRC, ESRC, NERC: sanctions for noncompliance



Funding for Research Data Management:

- Can be requested as part of the full economic cost of a research project.
- Can be used to support for example:
 - 。 staffing
 - Physical resources, e.g. storage
 - e.g. sharing data via Cambridge data repository: £5/GB



What do I need to do?

- For every new publication share what is shareable & add a statement
- Budget for Research Data Management in your grant applications
- Be aware of help available to you at the University of Cambridge



BBSRC	Biotechnology and biological sciences	Adherence to data management plan will be monitored and built into the Final Report score, which may be taken into account for future proposals Research data that supports publications must be stored for 10 years
British Heart Foundation	Medical research	"Safeguards should be in place to respect the confidentiality of patients, while also ensuring that medical researchers can gain access to patient data within a secure environment."
Cancer Research UK	Cancer research	Any applicants who consider that the data arising from their proposal will not be suitable for sharing must provide clear reasons for not making it available
EC (Horizon 2020)	Various disciplines	Running an Open Research Data Pilot, encouraging researchers to share data openly. Zenodo is the recommended repository where discipline-specific and institutional repositories are not available.
ERC	Various disciplines	Research data should be shared. Zenodo is the recommended repository where discipline-specific and institutional repositories are not available.
EPSRC	Engineering and physical sciences	EPSRC has the strictest policy on research data sharing. We have prepared separate, dedicated guidelines to help you achieve compliance with the EPSRC expectations.
ESRC	Economic and social sciences	Research data has to be deposited within three months of the end of the award. ESRC UK Data Service (UKDS) is the approved data repository for ESRC-funded research.
